Steadman Hawkins Clinic-Denver Joins UCHealth and CO to Grow Sports Performance Medicine and Orthopedic Program

Spacecon West is currently building a new, state-of-the-art health center off Inverness Drive in Englewood to provide a robust sports performance program including physical and occupational therapy, surgeries, imaging and clinic appointments. The program is designed to maximize performance and injury prevention for athletes at all levels.

The Inverness Health Center will Include:

- 90,000 square foot medical office building and surgery center
- Four operating rooms and additional treatment facilities
- Orthopedic clinic rooms
- Advanced imaging, including MRI and radiology
- State of the art rehabilitation and sports performance training center
- Human motion analytics for performance and injury prevention training.

Spacecon West's scope of work included the prefabrication and installation of the exterior metal stud wall panels, plus interior framing, drywall and finishing scopes.

St. Francis Medical Center Expansion Project

Spacecon West was pleased to join the GE Johnson IPD (Integrated Project Delivery) team for the St Francis Medical Center Expansion project.

The expansion includes 168,850 square feet of additional space. This five-story, \$165 million expansion is expected to include, a four-story expansion and a new garden level that will feature covered parking and an Emergency Medical Services lounge.

The first floor will be home to a new emergency department and additional shell space. The second floor will add three new operating rooms, support space and additional shell space for the future. The third floor will include a wellness garden, Neonatal Intensive Care Unity expansion, and ante partum rooms. The fourth floor will be for mechanical space.

With this addition, the hospital will expand to:

- 33 new Exam Rooms
- 23 PACU
- 24 NICU Rooms making it one of the regions premier birthing centers
- 4 new Operating Rooms

One of the challenges faced was creating the pre-fab Headwalls at an offsite location, for each specialty room. Each headwall required very specific layout dimensions for spacing, height and width due to critical med gas and electrical required for this type of critical care and would be installed as different area walls were installed on site.

Scope of work included exterior heavy gauge, sheathing, rigid insulation, spray applied air barrier, spray foam insulation, sound batt insulation, interior framing, drywall, acoustical and specialty ceilings.
