221 Elevations Condo & Residences – Is a Four-story building being built in Downtown Fort Collins. The building will consist of high-end condos, a bank, and other companies on the first floor. Our scope of work includes Framing, Drywall and Finishing.

Elevations Credit Union – Will be a Credit Union on the ground floor within the Elevations Condo & Residences building

221 Elevations C&S – Includes the Exterior and Interior Core and Shell scope.

Banner Sterling Pharmacy- Is an upgrade in the existing hospital for the cancer treatment unit

Kairo Residences @ Orchard Town Center – Is located in Westminster, a residential building in which we are contracted to attach faux brick to a ceiling

Greenwood village Secure Room – Secured job

Berthoud Elementary School Addition – Will include classrooms, common rooms, bathrooms, art rooms

Hulstrom K-8 Renovation- Will include classrooms, common rooms, bathrooms, art rooms

Ball Aerospace AMC Expansion- Office expansion for a secure area

SFMC 5th and 6th Floor Expansion – St. Francis Medical Center located in Colorado Springs. Is expanding two stories vertically adding 60 beds for post op patients.

The Sheraton Denver Downtown's renovation is thoroughly underway. It will forever change the face of the hotel and the 16th Street Mall. Sheraton Denver Downtown has long been a familiar anchor downtown, serving as the largest meetings/events hotel in the city with an unmatched heritage and roots deep in the local Denver community.

Sheraton Denver Downtown is one of the Sheraton brand's flagship properties. Its transformation journey will touch all aspects of the hotel including a new arrival experience, 133,000 square feet in renovated meeting space and 1,231 newly redesigned guest rooms.

Sheraton Denver Downtown started the transformation with the removal of the 5 iconic 18-foot ballerina statues that have welcomed guests and passersby since they were installed in 1997. The ballerinas found a new home in the Denver Arts District on Santa Fe, and their departure has made way for an improved guest arrival experience and modernized exterior, which will comprise the first phase of the renovation. The renovation consists of:

- Lobby/Driveway/Restaurants/ Club Lounge
- Guestrooms
- Plaza Ballroom and Foyer
- Newly reimagined hotel to be unveiled later this fall

Tynan Group LLC, is overseeing the development as the Project Management Company. Johnson Nathan Strohe (JNS) is serving as the lead architect on the renovation of the hotel's porte-cochere, façade and public spaces, while Kay Lang & Associates serve as the interior designer for the Plaza Ballroom. PWI Construction is serving as the general contractor for the public spaces. Currently we are working on renovating the new lobby and welcoming area. Please note: the jobsite visit occurred prior to face coverings becoming a COVID-19 requirement.



PWI has been able to create a safe and healthy work environment for our team. The bathrooms are fully functional and the rooms are wide open making social distancing easy to implement. Early April PWI arranged an appreciation luncheon for the jobsite. Each company was assigned a certain time based on the number of men on site. All employees were able to move through the jobsite and into the restaurant easily and swiftly all while keeping social distancing in play. The restaurant had a serving area set up allowing the employees to enter quickly two at a time.
