UAL—A West Club Earns Safety Recognition From Turner Construction

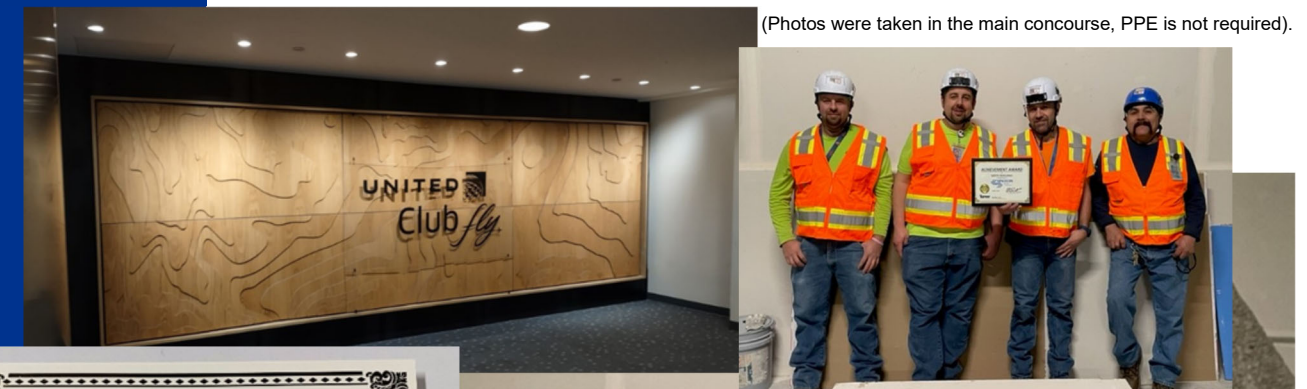
UAL – A West Club earns Safety Recognition from Turner Construction

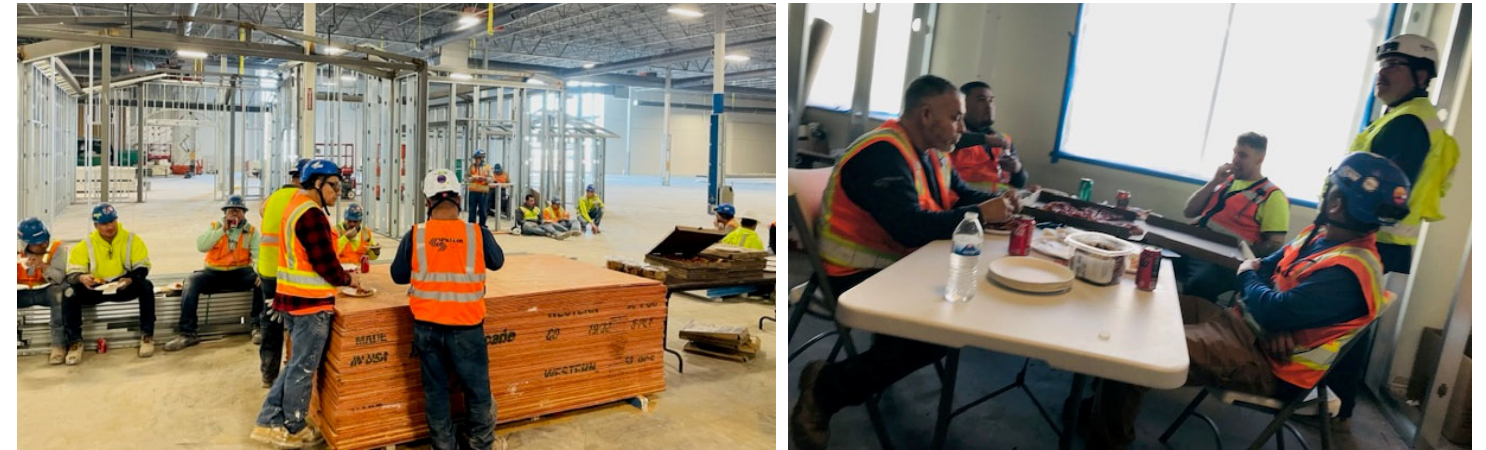
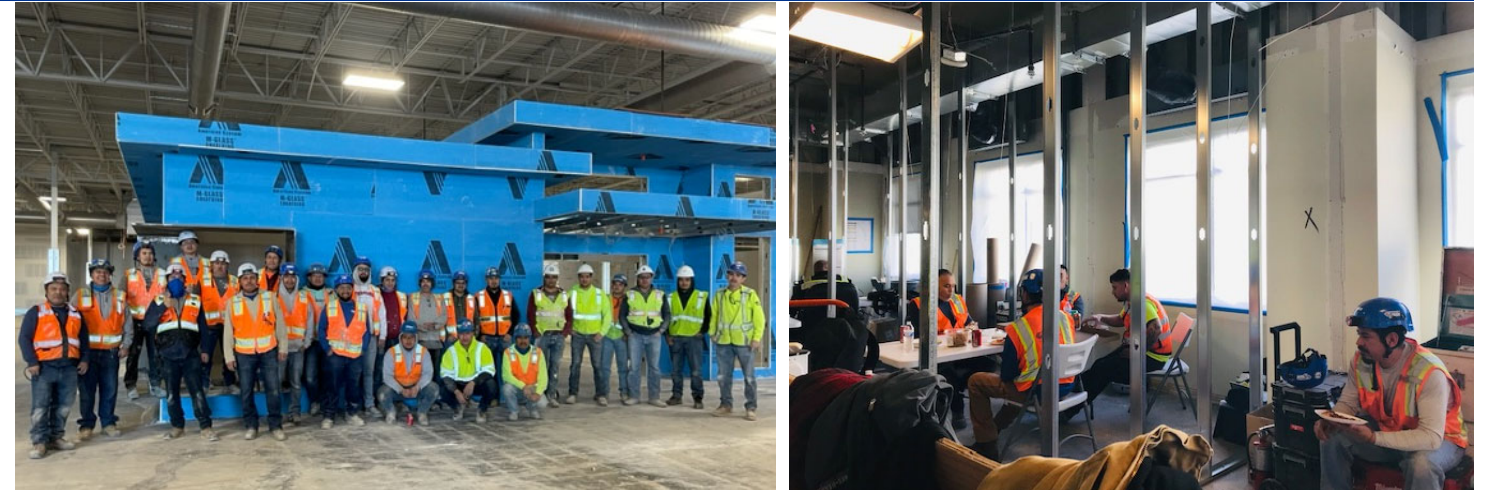


2022 Safety Record—Safety Lunches
