Innovated Tools Creating Efficient Processes

Evolution is a must for all. Currently as a company, we are testing and trying innovative tools to help our field become as efficient as possible. We are always looking for new tools to test that help productivity and the safety of our team. Currently in use we are focusing on the Total Station. The total station is an electronic/optical instrument used in surveying and building construction. It uses electronic transit theodolite in conjunction with electronic distance meter (EDM). It is also integrated with microprocessor, electronic data collector and storage system.

The instrument is used to measure sloping distance of object to the instrument, horizontal angles and vertical angles. This Microprocessor unit enables for computation of data collected to further calculate the horizontal distance, coordinates of a point and reduced level of point.



Data collected from total station can be downloaded into computer/laptops for further processing of information. The total station has helped perfect our layout design with close to zero discrepancies. “The Hilti PLT 300 layout tool continues to be a very valuable tool for us as it shows in the end results” states Kevin Emerson. Notable projects include: ENT, COS 2, Altru and other projects within Colorado and Wyoming.

As a company we know having the ability to create a 360 vision of your jobsite allows you to see the sophistication or your site and scope. Currently we are using open space cameras to provide this information. The camera is worn and all you do is turn the 360° camera on, tap go, and just walk your site. The OpenSpace Vision Engine maps photos to your plans automatically and it's lightning fast with average 15-minute processing times—not hours, not days.

Kevin Emerson states, “I am very excited to have rolled out our Drywall saw on a large scale. This will not only improve production but quality as well.”
